

1. OVERVIEW





About the YCP program



- Open to youth 18-35 years old
- Nine-month program starting in January 2022
- Multi-generational and Peer-to-Peer
- Learning Exchange and Collaboration with Small and Medium organizations
- Increase contribution to Public Engagement of Canadians
- We do not fund development projects
- International applicants must have a <u>Canadian connection</u> with a SMO before the beginning of the program
- All youth applicants must apply jointly with a SMO.
- Canadian youth will be invited to participate in the Spur Change conference that will take place in May 2022 in Montréal.

- Time 5 hours/week
- Language English and/or French
- Communications Reliable
 Internet or Phone Line*
- Training Webinars, Meetings
- Public Engagement Online and Offline*
- Monitoring and Evaluation

Expectations for SMOs

- Meet the GAC definition of SMOs*
- Be willing to contribute up to 5
 hours/week to this initiative for the
 duration of the program
- Having a lead or point person
 with whom the Youth Champion
 will be working
- Have the means to facilitate

2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION

Process



- 1. Review eligibility criteria
- 2. Youth and SMO review program objectives and expectations together
- 3. Youth and SMO apply individually on the same application form by December 3rd
- 4. Applicants will be notified of results of the selection process by **December 23rd**
- 5. Participants will be sent a Letter of Agreement that they will have to sign by **the end of January**



5. FINANCIAL MATTERS

Spur Change Contribution

- Public Engagement Youth and SMO will have a total of CAD \$500 available to them to pay for admissible expenses
- Youth Stipend Each youth who successfully finishes the training will receive CAD \$200
- Travel Canadian Youth Canadian youth will be invited to participate in the conference in May 2022 (Montreal)
- Travel International Youth No travel is expected for international participants due to the COVID pandemic preventing international travel



Considerations

- Spur Change will make international transfers only when there are no other options. When feasible, SMOs will receive the stipends for international youth and reimbursement for admissible expenses.
- Youth and SMO participants will have to collaborate in allocating and managing budget using the guidelines for admissible expenses
- All expenses have to be pre-approved by Spur Change team
